in 1821 at the age of seventy seven thomas jefferson decided to state some recollections of dates and facts concerning myself his ancestors jefferson writes came to america from wales in the early seventeenth century and settled in the virginia colony jefferson s father although uneducated possessed a strong mind and sound judgement and raised his family in the far western frontier of the colony an experience that contributed to his son s eventual staunch defense of individual and state rights jefferson attended the college of william and mary entered the law and in 1775 was elected to represent virginia at the continental congress in philadelphia an event that propelled him to all of his future political fortunes jefferson s autobiography continues through the entire revolutionary war period and his insights and information about persons politics and events including the drafting of the declaration of independence his service in france with benjamin franklin and his observations on the french revolution are of immense value to both scholars and general readers jefferson ends this account of his life at the moment he returns to new york to become secretary of state in 1790 complementing the other major autobiography of the period benjamin franklin s the

calvin coolidge served as the thirtieth president of the united states from 1923 1929 famously taciturn his nickname was silent cal and his autobiography does nothing to disabuse him of that legend where theodore roosevelt s autobiography is a weighty 214 000 words and ulysses s grant s personal memoirs clock in at a hefty 273 000 words this volume is a terse 44 000 words coolidge wastes no time in describing his childhood in vermont where his father a respected pillar of the community raised him in an environment that valued hard work modesty and education though idyllic in setting this upbringing is tinged with loss in the early deaths of his grandfather mother and sister he then recounts his career in the law followed by his speedy ascent into politics and the vice presidency under warren g harding when harding dies suddenly in 1923 on a trip to san francisco coolidge who was visiting his family home finds himself being sworn to the office of the president by his father under the lamplight of a modest country house his first abbreviated term ends with him a popular president and after winning the election in 1924 he ultimately declines to run for a second full term stating that if i take another term i will be in the white house till 1933 ten years in washington is longer than any other man has had it too long those starting this autobiography may expect it to focus on the time coolidge spent as the most powerful man in the world but coolidge devotes few words to discussing the actual events that occurred during his presidency preferring to talk about his upbringing and his broad views on government and character he does however recount what a day in the life of the president looks like and as one might expect the average day is extremely busy and carefully scheduled despite its brevity coolidge s autobiography reveals a portrait of a thoughtful considerate man who cared much for his countrymen and held modesty and hard work as two of the most important traits a leader can have this book is part of the standard ebooks project which produces free public domain ebooks

more essays the silence dogood essays which are also published when ben reveals his authorship james is angered thinking the recognition of his papers will make ben too vain james and ben have frequent disputes and ben seeks for a way to escape from working under james

clark was a man who without being himself a recognized new thought leader has been highly influential in introducing new thought ideas and techniques into the churches clark was deeply religious and something of a mystic a great believer in prayer he first came into prominence through an article in the atlantic monthly titled the soul s sincere desire he began to be much in demand as a speaker in the churches and in summer camps in 1930 he organized a summer camp of his own in koronis minnesota to which he gave the name camp farthest out here for a period amidst pleasant surroundings a group of congenial and serious minded people met for a season of fellowship relaxation and spiritual renewal under the direction of dr clark and others of somewhat similar views in 1942 he resigned from his position at the college to give all his time to helping others discover this integration of body mind and spirit in god through a series of experiences told in his autobiography a man s reach he had been brought to an unusual interest in prayer and it became his major concern and emphasis it set him to reading especially the works of the mystics and about them and their approach to god among the books he read was life understood by frank rawson a onetime christian scientist who had been expelled from the church and went on to become an influential leader of new thought in england the thing that attracted clark to rawson he says was that he believed one s prayers could be just as scientifically infallible as the laws of physics and chemistry print ed
